



ALA ILL CODE UPDATE

3. *Material Which Should Not Be Applied For*

Current fiction; any book requested for a trivial purpose, or which is available in other libraries more readily accessible to the applicant, or which can be applied to a public library, current material which can readily be purchased and for which there is no demand in a public library.

4. *Material Which Should Be Applied For Under Exceptional Circumstances*

Material in constant use; books of reference; books to be taken from the library without special permission; material whose size or character requires expensive insurance; material which by reason of its texture, or fragile condition, is likely to suffer from being sent by mail or express.

Code of Practice for
Interlibrary Loans

PURPOSE

- X To establish principles that facilitate the requesting of material by a library and the provision of loans or copies in response to those requests.
- X To regulate the exchange of material between libraries in the United States.



STRUCTURE

- X Requesting Library
- X Supplying Library

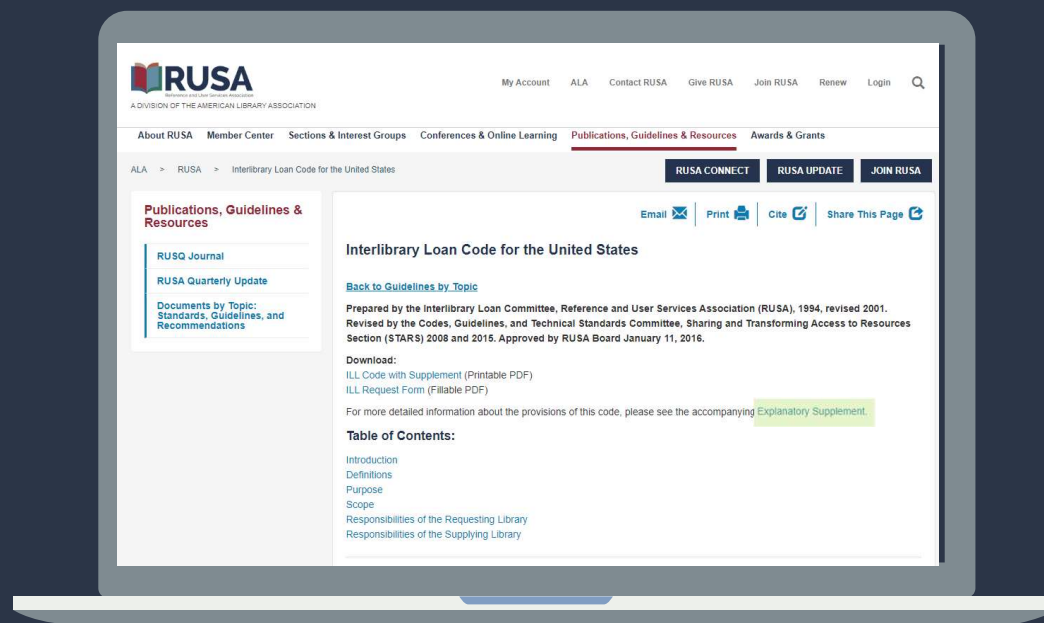
- X Topics include policies, payment, copyright, responsibility for use restrictions, loss or damage, etc.

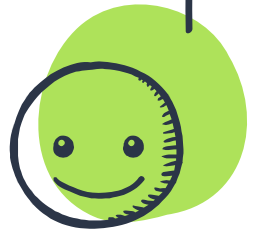
- X Reviewed and updated **every 7 years** per ALA and RUSA guidelines

FALL 2022

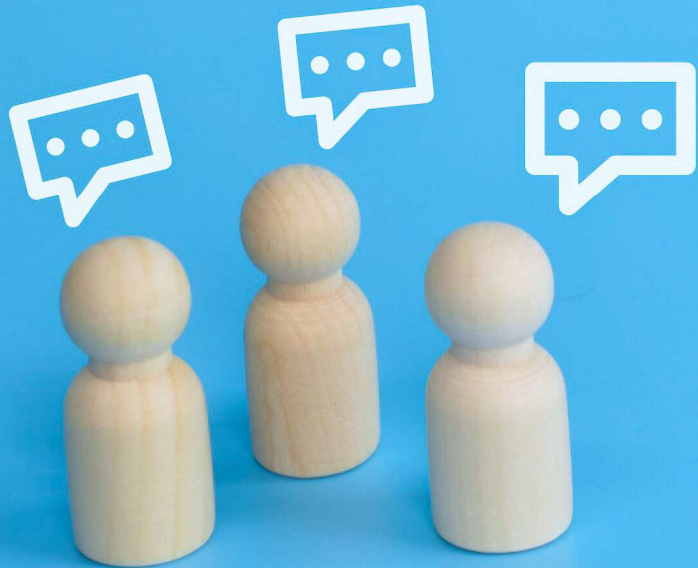
- X More committee reviews/revisions
